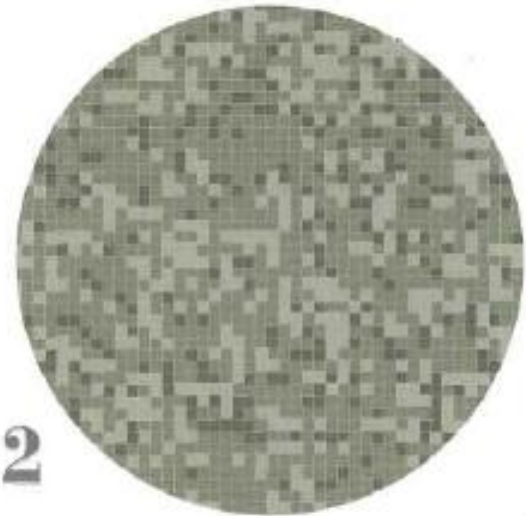

1. A realistic reproduction of a basic building material, Abstracts 5306 Chalk White Concrete from **LaminArt** offers an unveiled look that is authentic in every nuance—down to the markings left by pressboards. Abstracts Concrete is also available in Natural Gray and Fly Ash colors.

4. From **Porcelanosa**, Krion is a non-porous, uniform solid surface material, made of one-third organic material (high-quality polyester polymer resin) and two-thirds natural minerals (alumina). It's a new generation of solid surface that is warm to the touch and similar to stone, available in a variety of colors.
